



## TEACHER'S GUIDE

The **Classroom Guides** for *Black History: The Movement* are designed to help students expand the conversation of what it means to be Black in America as well as explore the concept of what does freedom mean. The classroom guides also provide questions for students to answer following watching the companion video. There are 4 videos in all, each focusing on different ethnicities within the black community.

After completing the Classroom Guides, have the students share their own experience. Engage with a classroom discussion around these three questions:

- **Who are you?**
- **What does your name mean?** *If you have access to the Internet, check to see if your name has a special meaning and what does that mean to each student.*
- **What does it mean to be freedom mean to you?**
